Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am excited about the prospect of Lay Eucharistic Ministers here at Trinity. We have had 16 people sign up on Time and Ability Sheets, and we could use more. What will these people do? Let me share.

In a congregation our size, with so many people to care for, we will be training members to take communion to our home-bound members, as well as to people in the hospital. We will team up one lay person with one or two home-bound members. They will visit these members once a month, so they will give one morning or afternoon a month to this ministry. They will get to know the home-bound member and will be able to communicate any needs or concerns to the pastors.

We will also have Lay members visit our hospitalized folks on the weekend, freeing the pastors from this duty on the weekend. The pastors will cover Monday - Thursdays, and of course emergencies that occur at any time. Why are we doing this? Because your pastors need additional help, and are putting in way too many hours, neglecting themselves and their families.

If you are interested in helping with this important new ministry, talk to me. We have the training set for February 20<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 - 4:30. Please help us. Remember what it says on that column to the left...Ministers: the Members of Trinity. That is all of us! And we can really use you right now.

Finally, I want to encourage you to be faithful this Lenten season. We are all so busy, but let us take time for refreshment, renewal, and repentance. See you in worship on Sundays and Wednesday nights. And come enjoy a meal with us on Wednesdays!
