More exciting news! At the January Parish Planning Council meeting, we decided to enter into the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Gettysburg Intern Program. This means that we will be bringing a seminary intern on board in June. The intern will come to Trinity and practice and do ministry as part of their third year of seminary training. So we will have the intern from June until May of 2011, and then select another intern to follow. We will use the money originally budgeted for the visitation pastor to underwrite the cost of this program.

I believe Trinity has a great deal to offer an intern, and as I was told at the recent Intern Matching Workshop, we were a very popular sight. All our interview time slots were taken, with others trying to meet with me throughout the day. It was an exciting process, and it was interesting to hear their thoughts and aspirations. Most said they liked the diversity of our ministries and they had a lot of questions about the details of those varied programs.

The seminarian, or Vicar as we will call her or him, will preach once a month, help with visitation, assist in worship, and get involved in all of the different ministries at Trinity. He or she will lead Bible Studies, Sunday School, and work their way through all of our boards and their respective ministries. The goal is to give them a broad perspective of the ministries of the church. You will help them to become a better pastor!

We will find out in March who has been assigned to us, and I will go to a supervisor's team building workshop May 18-19. So for now, pray that God will create a good match for us as we venture into this new ministry, serving the broader church in helping to train future leaders, and getting some additional help and new ideas here at Trinity. May God bless us always in always! Be faithful this Lenten season!
